The coach application consists of 3 sections and will ask for the following details:

1. Personal Information
 - a. Contact information;
 - b. Demographic background;
 - c. Education and professional background; and,
 - d. Program-specific information.

2. Application Questions
 - a. Six open-ended discussion questions;
 - b. Your updated resume and biography.

3. Social Media Information (only used if you are selected as Young Director)
 - a. Social Media Links; and,
 - b. Headshot.

The application portal will close on Sunday, May 5th at 23:59 Eastern Time.

1. Why do you want to volunteer as a Coach and how would you draw upon your lived experiences to support a Young Director? (200 word limit)
2. Fora makes an effort to not only mentor young directors but connect them with values-driven individuals who are willing to act as sponsors for them. What spaces, tools, events, or networks do you have access to which you would be comfortable sharing with your young director as they navigate their leadership journey? (200 word limit)
3. What does a successful coaching relationship look like to you? (200 word limit)
4. How have you integrated Justice, Equity, Diversity, and Inclusion (JEDI) principles in your past projects/initiatives? Please provide a specific example, describe your role in these efforts and explain how you demonstrated leadership or commitment to JEDI principles. (200 word limit)
5. Young Directors can sometimes experience microaggressions or tokenizing attitudes from their participating board. How would you provide support to your Young Director, if they experienced this? (200 word limit)
6. Do you have governance experience?

7. Upload your CV/Resume.
8. Please provide a brief biography. (200 word limit)
